



POOL RULES

PRIVATE HIRE | NO LIFEGUARD



No lifeguard is on duty. Never swim alone. The lead booker is responsible for making sure everyone in the group understands and follows these rules.

BEFORE YOU SWIM

- 1 Remove outdoor shoes on entry and place them in the rack provided.
- 2 Everyone must shower before entering the pool.
- 3 Do not swim if you are unwell, medically unfit, or affected by alcohol or drugs.
- 4 Do not swim during diarrhoea or vomiting, or for 48 hours after symptoms stop. After diagnosed cryptosporidiosis, wait 14 days after diarrhoea stops.
- 5 Babies and toddlers who are not fully toilet trained must wear a suitable swim nappy.

SUPERVISION AND CAPACITY

- 6 No more than six people may be in the water at any one time.
- 7 No person may swim alone. At least two people must be present.
- 8 Children, weak swimmers and non-swimmers must be actively supervised by a responsible adult at all times.

IN AND AROUND THE POOL

- 9 The pool cover must be fully removed before anyone enters the water.
- 10 Never stand, sit, jump or place any weight on the pool cover or cover roller.
- 11 No diving, jumping, bombing, running, rough play or dangerous behaviour.
- 12 No food or glass in the pool room. Smoking and vaping are prohibited throughout the building.
- 13 Jewellery must be removed before swimming.
- 14 Do not enter the plant room or tamper with pool equipment, controls or electrical equipment.

AT THE END OF YOUR SESSION

- 15 Keep to your booked time and leave the water promptly. Occupying the next slot may result in an additional charge.
- 16 Mop up surface water in the shower area and toilets to reduce the risk of slips.
- 17 Leave the building clean and tidy, and take all personal belongings with you.
- 18 Report any accident, near-miss, contamination, damage or equipment problem to management immediately.

IN AN EMERGENCY

If anyone is in difficulty, call 999 immediately. You can also alert management by pressing the Ring video doorbell located to the left of the notice board, or call 07482 107962. Follow the marked emergency exits and keep access clear for the emergency services.

By using the pool, all users agree to follow these rules. Access may be refused or ended for a serious or repeated breach, or where behaviour creates a safety risk. Personal belongings and vehicles are left at the user's own risk. Nothing in these rules excludes liability that cannot legally be excluded.

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
